In the ARBOR, tall trees will wear *Rings of Life*, a site-specific installation by **Yareth Fernández** that externalizes the age of each tree by representing each tree ring with a colorful fabric stripe around the trunk: "My artwork is centered on the changing relationship between people and nature, and explores their similarities, differences, patterns, and by-products." www.yarethfernandez.com

In the CUBE, **Michele Hogan** will show recent drawings investigating hair as a uniter or divider in society. Carrying the baggage of female worth, personal origin, and class, hair also catches light and shadow, constantly moving and changing.
